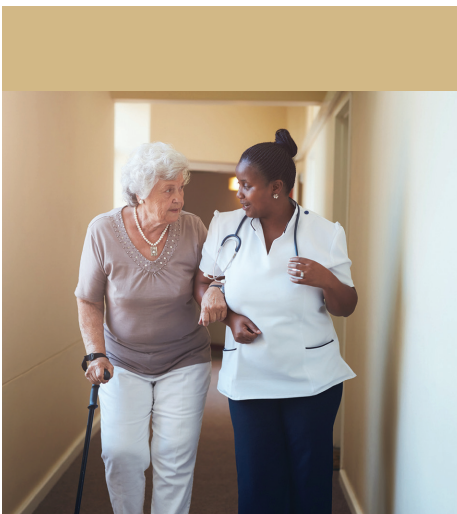
NEW CMS COMPLIANCE STANDARDS ARE NOW IN EFFECT. WE CAN ENSURE YOU'RE READY.

In an effort to increase patient safety through more consistent responses to natural or human-caused disasters, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has issued a new set of rules concerning emergency preparedness for healthcare providers. In addition to promoting higher levels of preparedness, these new regulations are mandatory for any facility or provider that accepts federal and state funding.

Compliance with these new regulations became mandatory on November 15, 2017.

Communications Planning – By incorporating best practices into your Emergency Operations Plan, you can coordinate patient care and support services within your facility and across healthcare providers, as well as with state and local public health departments and emergency systems.

Training & Exercise – We design and conduct initial and annual healthcare-related emergency training and testing, including exercises ranging from tabletop discussions to full-scale scenario-based offerings in collaboration with your community and other healthcare coalition partners.
